The French Minor requires a minimum of **15 upper-division credits** listed under FRNCH. At least 6 credits have to be taken at the University of Utah (Bridge Program courses count as courses taken at the U). Courses taught in English are limited to 3 credits to count for the degree. All courses must be passed with a grade of C or better. CR?NC may NOT be elected for these courses.

Students must complete lower-division language sequence of 1010, 1020, 2010, and 2020, or the equivalent, before enrolling in FRNCH 3040 or 3050.
